## Description of Oasis & Oasis Wide Laminate Flooring

Oasis and Oasis Wide laminate flooring (Oasis) is a direct pressure laminate flooring comprising a high density fibreboard (HDF) core which is then coated with a melamine resin that is reinforced with aluminium oxide.

It is intended for interior use including where exposed to watersplash but is not intended for use in areas of high humidity (e.g. saunas) or wet areas (e.g. shower enclosures).

The boards are 1261 mm in length, 8 mm thick and either 244 mm or 192 mm wide. The boards are finished with the Uniclic® locking system for simple installation.

The boards are installed as a floating floor and sealed around the perimeter with a compressible PE foam rod which is then sealed with Hydroshield® sealant. This ensures that the floor is waterproof whilst still allowing for expansion and contraction.

Woodland supply accessories to aid in the installation:

- underlay to reduce sound transfer
- custom stair trims, and

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- colour matched trims or aluminium C channels.

For a concrete substrate and where the moisture content is &gt; 6 %, a layer of 6 ml polyethylene may be installed.</li><li>• Oasis may not be laid over the following substrates:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>- Carpet underlay or carpet</li><li>- Cushioned back vinyl</li><li>- Engineered or solid hardwood over concrete</li><li>- Rubber</li><li>- Cork</li><li>- PVC flooring</li><li>- Other free floating floors.</li></ul></li><li>• Substrates must not slope more than 25 mm per 1.83 m in any direction.</li><li>• Maximum deflection of the substrate must be &lt; 1/360.</li><li>• Substrates must be smooth and free of roughness with no changes in elevation.
